Welcome to Reception, we all hope you have had a fantastic summer. Please find below key dates for your diary and general information for the weeks ahead.

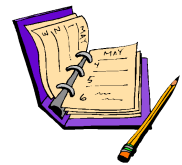

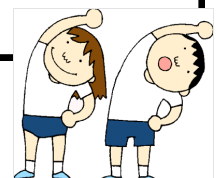
Join In Afternoon— Tuesday 9th October
