

Mablethorpe Primary School Knowledge Organiser

Term 1 - UKS2

Prior Knowledge: You have been learning about our local town Mablethorpe.

Drawing:

We will be learning how to draw perspective which adds greater realism to pictures, rather than creating a 'flat' picture, when drawing buildings within Mablethorpe.



Painting:

Brusho is a powder paint which has a type of ink effect. It can be used both wet and dry to create different effects. We will use it to add coloured perspective to the buildings we have drawn.



Vocabulary:

Landscape: when it is wider than it is tall.

Portrait: when it is taller than it is wide.

Horizon line: where the sky meets the land or sea in a picture.

Perspective: perspective drawings make two dimensional objects appear three dimensional.

One- point perspective: the lines of perspective will eventually meet at one point.

Artist link:

L.S Lowry is a famous English artist (1887-1976). Lowry made objects appear nearer or further away in his paintings. The buildings became smaller and paler as they got further away to show perspective.
