New Vocabulary

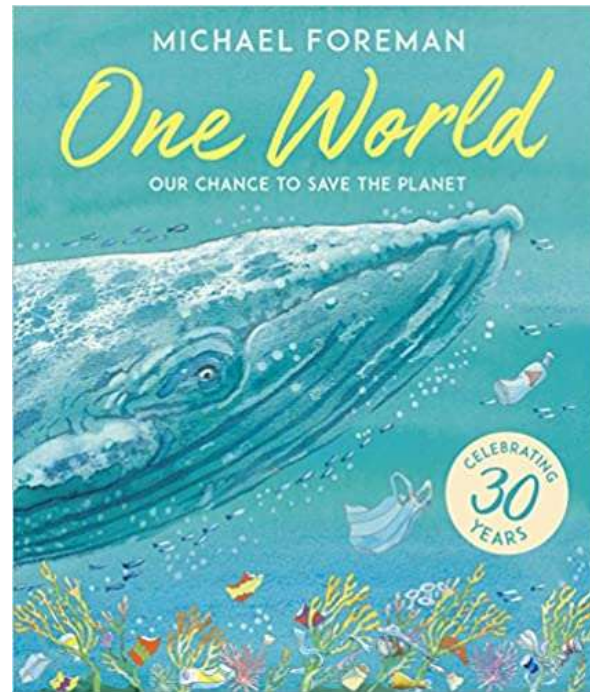
plunge - a verb meaning to move or make somebody/something move suddenly.

caress- a verb meaning to touch something gently.

desolate- an adjective to describe a place which is empty and without people or living things.

desolate - can also be a verb - the feeling of being very lonely and unhappy.

Vast - an adjective meaning extremely large area, size or amount.

New Grammar and meanings for this unit of work

prepositions	A preposition is a word that tells you where or when something is in relation to something else. Examples of prepositions include words like after, before, on, under, with.
Expanded noun phrases	Expanded noun phrases tell you more about the noun for example, the tall girl
Conjunctions to express time or cause	A word used to link clauses within a sentence. Some examples of conjunctions to express time are: before, after, as, when, while, until, since. Examples of cause include the terms: for this reason, as, because, therefore, as a result, consequently, since, so
Clauses	A group of words that includes a subject and a verb to form a simple sentence or only part of a sentence:
