## **New Grammar and meanings for this unit of work**

Finger spaces	You leave a space between each word you write.
Full stops	At the end of a sentence you need a full stop. This sits on the line.
Capital letter	All sentences must start with a capital letter
Noun	A noun is a person, place, object ( bed, bear, fridge, owl, clock are all nouns)
Adjective	An adjective describes a noun ( big bear, hard bed, noisy fridge)
Sentence	A group of words that are put together to mean something.
