



Book bags and Reading Crowns

We hope that your child has settled in well at school and your child is now coming home with a book bag. This book bag needs to be returned daily please.

Your child's reading books will be changed on a Tuesday and Thursday, please sign and comment in their reading record to show that your child has read. New sounds will be added as the children learn them. They will also bring home a chosen book that your child has chosen to enjoy with you.

The pink homework book allows children to be able to practise sounds and numbers if you wish. This is optional and it is important to remember if the child gets restless then stop!

We will be starting a fun new reading initiative for the children to enjoy. If they read 4 times in one week (Thursday to Thursday) and their reading log has been signed they will get to wear a reading crown on a Friday. Every time your child gets to wear the reading crown their name will be put in a hat. At the end of each term lucky winners will get a prize for their fantastic reading.

As a parent all you need to do is sit with your child and hear them read some of their reading book that is in their reading log and write a small comment and sign the reading log. There is an example below.
