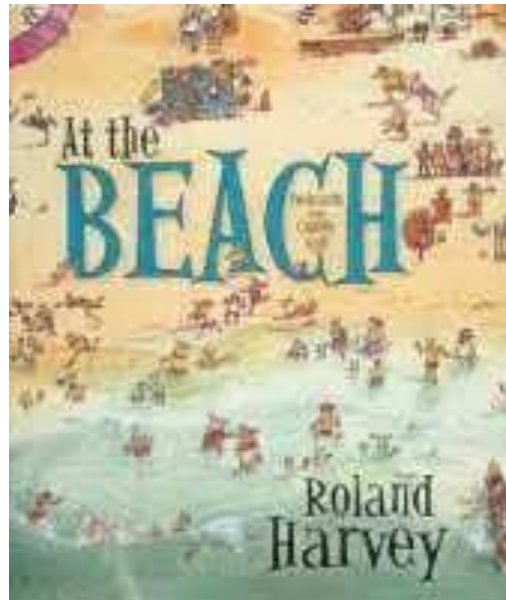


At the beach

In this unit of work, Children will explore the features of a postcard and write one themselves. They will compose sentences orally and sequence them. The children will create a story about a holiday to Mablethorpe, reviewing their writing in the past tense. They will use prefixes, suffixes, and contractions.

New Grammar and meanings for this unit of work

Noun	A noun is a person, place, object (seagull, huts, sandcastle, beach are all nouns)
Adjective	An adjective describes a noun (sandy, yellow, huge, cold)
Verb	A verb is a word used to describe an action, state or occurrence (jumping, running, likes, became)
Sentence	A group of words that are put together to mean something.
Suffix and prefix	a suffix is an affix which is placed after the stem of a word and a prefix is an affix which is placed before the stem word.
Contractions	a contraction is a shortened form of a group of words
