

Geography Why do people come to Mablethorpe? Year 1 Knowledge Organiser

Autumn Term 5 and 6

Key Questions: What do you like to do in Mablethorpe? What is the land used for in Mablethorpe? How are farms and the beach different? What human and physical features are there in Mablethorpe? What transport is there in Mablethorpe? Why do tourists come to Mablethorpe? When do people visit Mablethorpe? Why do people come to Mablethorpe?

Prior Knowledge: Children will have learnt about where they live and what country they live in. They will have explored physical/human features.

Overview: Throughout this unit children will be learning about why tourists come to Mablethorpe. They will look at what attracts people to Mablethorpe, when people come to Mablethorpe and what transport there is in Mablethorpe.

Definitions:

<u>Seaside</u> - the area near the sea, especially where people spend their holidays and enjoy themselves

Land use - What the land is used for

<u>coast</u> - the part of the land adjoining or near the sea.

<u>Human/ Physical Geography</u> - Features of land that have been impacted by human activity/ natural features of land.

Tourism- the movement of people to countries or places outside their usual environment

<u>Transport</u>- a system or means of conveying people or goods from place to place.
