

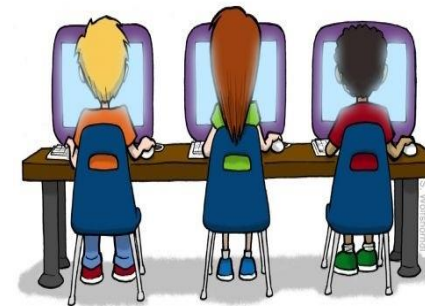
Learning Objectives:

Key Vocabulary

power	To influence another person
control	The power to influence or direct people's behaviour.
assertive	Being able to stand up for your own or another person's rights in a calm and positive way.
influence	To have an effect on another person's behaviour.
pressure	To use persuasion or intimidation to make someone do something.
strategies	A plan of action to help you solve a problem.
