Key Questions

Why do we have rules in our school? Why might people need a helping hand to follow the straight path? Who is Muhammad? How is Allah described in the Quran? What do Muslims learn about Allah and their faith through the Quran?

Prior Knowledge from EYFS: This Year 1 and 2 Unit builds up from the Lincolnshire Agreed Syllabus Unit Our special books which introduces stories from religions and important books for members of a religious group. Children will have previously learnt that the Quran is a special book to Muslims and they will have also been introduced to Islamic artefacts such as prayer beads and prayer mats.

Children will learn how is Allah described in the Quran and will learn about what Muslims learn about Allah and their faith through the Quran. They will learn about the Islamic belief of One God who created the universe in harmony and who created human beings to help keep the universe in harmony. They will learn about how Muslims believe in the straight path to help keep the universe in harmony. They will learn that Muslims believe that the Quran provides guidance to help humans follow the straight path. Children will also learn that Muslims have 99 Names of Allah to show ways in which Muslims try to understand what God is like. They will learn about the Prophet Muhammad and will learn the story about the Prophet Muhammad receiving the Quran (the 'Night of Power')
