




Christianity - Being Human

What does the Bible say about how Christians should treat others and live their lives?
How can Christian faith and beliefs be seen in the actions of inspirational Christians?

Prior Knowledge: This unit builds upon the Year 1 Units of What do Christians learn and understand about God through Old Testament Bible stories? and What do Christians do to express their beliefs? Children will have explored the concept that Christians believe that humans are created by God in his image (Genesis 1:26-27) and the belief that humans are created to look after God's creation. Children will have learned the story of Moses and the Ten Commandments and the Christian belief that Jesus was the incarnation of God.

<p>The New Commandment is a term used in Christianity to describe Jesus's commandment to "love one another"</p> <p>Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. In this Year 2 Unit the children will learn that Christians believe that the Bible is the Holy word of God and it contains information of how humans should live their lives and tell right from wrong. They will learn that Christians believe that humans should love God and love their neighbour as themselves (Mark 12:30-31). The children will explore these concepts and beliefs by reading stories from the Gospels, e.g. the parable of the Good Samaritan, Lost Son and The Lost Sheep.
