

Overview: You will learn that Christians believe that God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings. They also believe that as human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God. Christians believe the Bible shows them that God wants to help people to be close to him and He keeps his relationship with them by giving them guidelines on good ways to live (such as the Ten Commandments).

This unit will include the book *Dear Earth* by Isabelle Otter. This book is about a little girl called Tessa, who wants everyone to know how special the Earth is. The book links well with the world view of Stewardship, which is a common theme among religious and non-religious people.

2) Christians believe that humans were created to look after the world and everything

3) The Fall of Adam and Eve



The Bible says that the Devil entered into a serpent and tempted Eve (**Genesis 3:1**). He got Eve to doubt God's Word. Satan told her that God knew that Eve would become enlightened and possess the same knowledge as God had if she ate from the fruit of the tree.



4) Christians believe that Adam and Eve's act spoiled the friendship between humans and God and that humans cannot get close to God again without God's help.
