Outdoor Learning	Encouraging powerful, exciting, inspirational learning which makes it valuable in overcoming problems, working together and creating a sense of awe and wonder of the world. We enable children to be confident individuals and impact positively upon young children's attitudes beliefs and self-perceptions. We provide important opportunities for the health and well-being of every child through outdoor learning opportunities.	Allowing children to experience the relationship between their actions and the natural world and teach responsibility towards Environmental issues. Encouraging positive behaviour and encourage children to develop a sense of right from wrong and with an understanding of consequences. To help foster attitudes of stewardship and responsibility towards the grounds and environment which can become an important asset both for them and the local community. It encourages the understanding of why we need to follow rules, reasons why we have rules and possible consequences if the rules are broken.	We provide opportunities through outdoor learning to develop communication, co-operation, compassion and emphasise the importance of certain rules and boundaries. Children will create and develop personal relationships, based on trust, self-esteem and mutual respect through outdoor activities and children learn to value everyone equally through their contributions. We encourage children to develop their sense of identity and belonging. It promotes a deeper understanding of concepts than traditional subject boundaries. Outdoor learning opportunities contributes towards creating independent learners with high self-esteem and self-sufficiency. Outdoor learning has a positive impact upon children's behaviour. It raises learners' attainment, promotes and strengthens communication skills, team work and sense of cohesion.	Outdoor Learning allows children to develop values and opinions that are informed by first- hand experience of the natural world which in turn helps them to appreciate and value the natural resources in their local and Global environment. We encourage children to develop an understanding of the world in which they live and the interdependence of individuals, groups and nations upon and within the environment. We encourage community cohesion and allow children to develop as responsible citizens who make a positive contribution to their wider community. It can create pride in the school and wider community and promote community involvement, renewing children's pride and creating a sense of belonging and responsibility.

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
