Holidays should not be taken during term time.

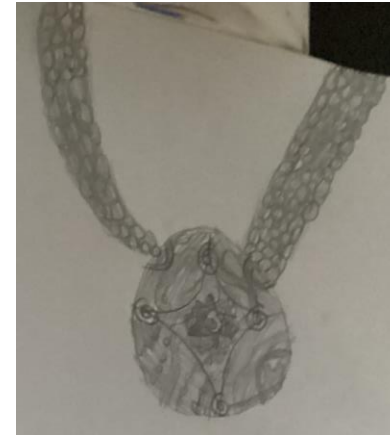
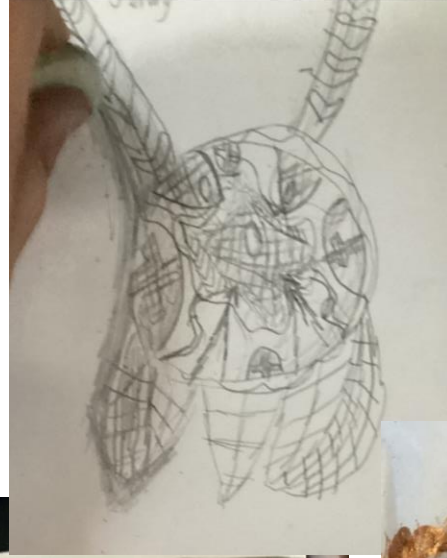

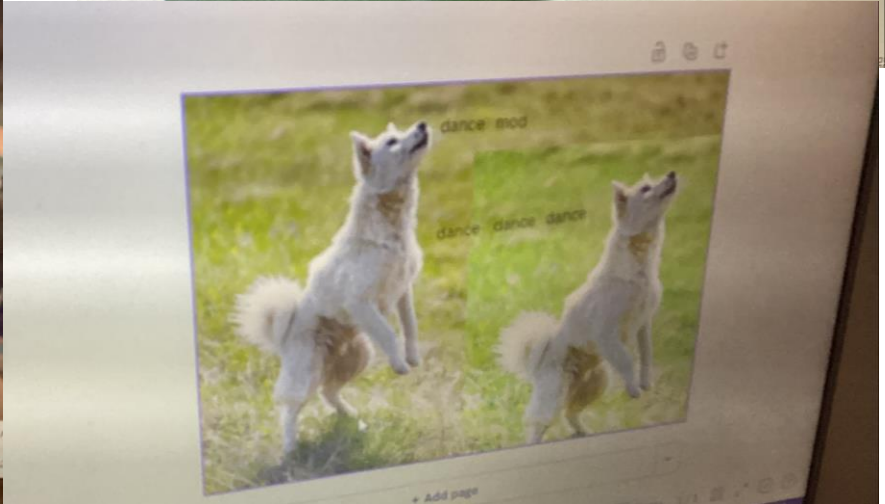
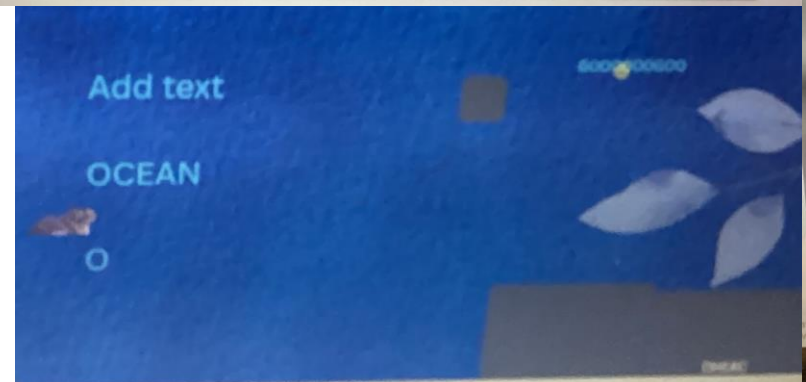
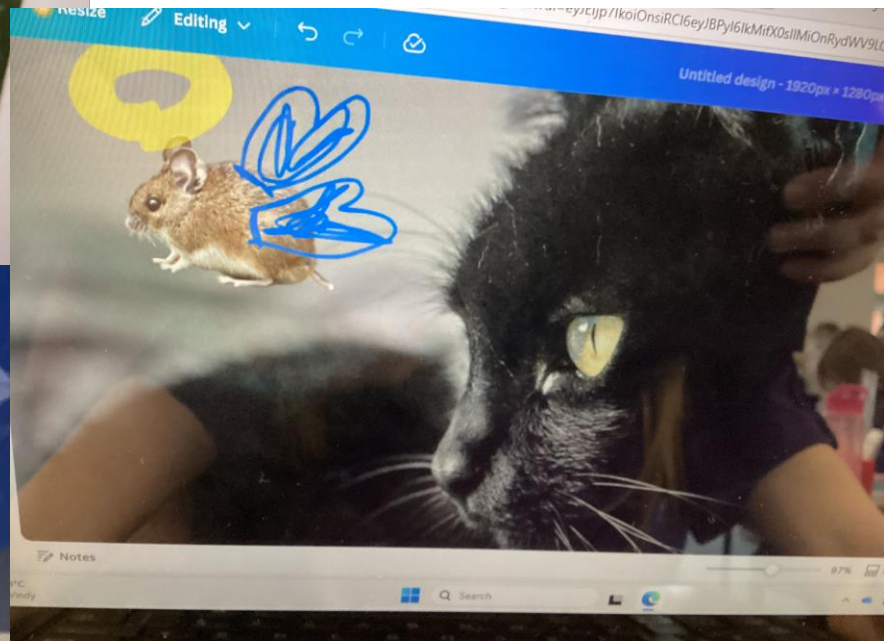
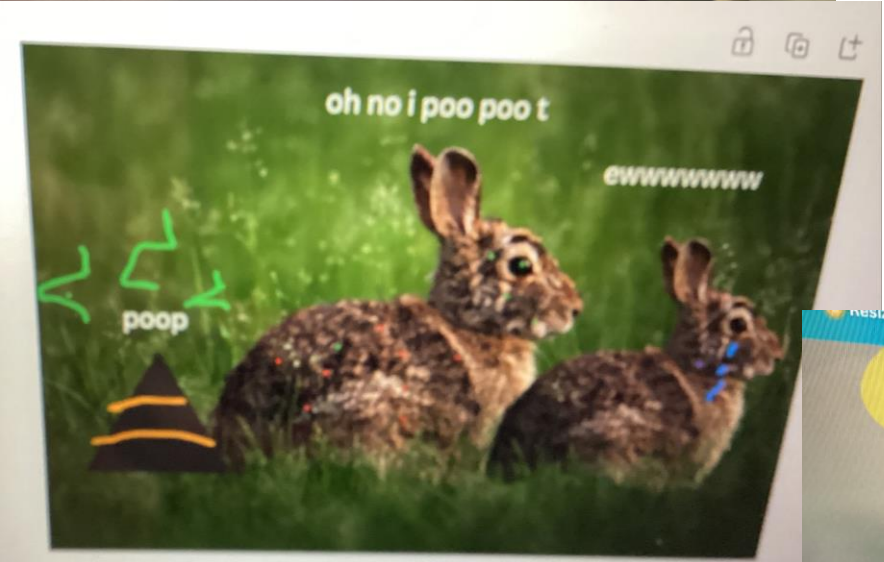
Attendance Matters

Seals have been using Canva to edit photos and create their own scenes in computing

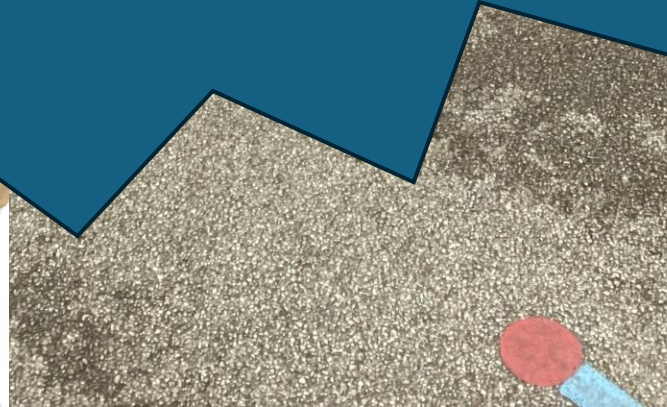


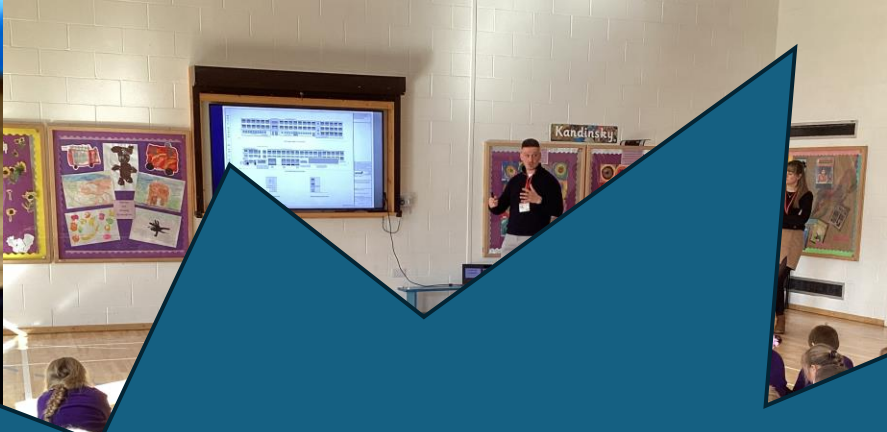


Puffins Class

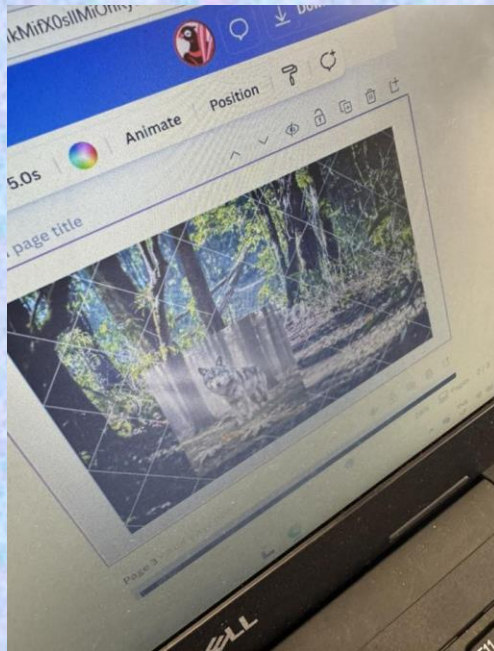

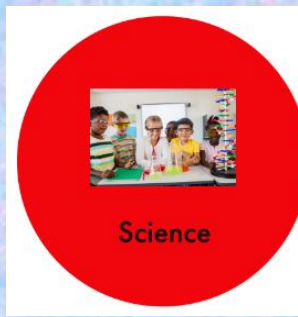
Our visit to St. Mary's church.
