Holidays should not be taken during term time.

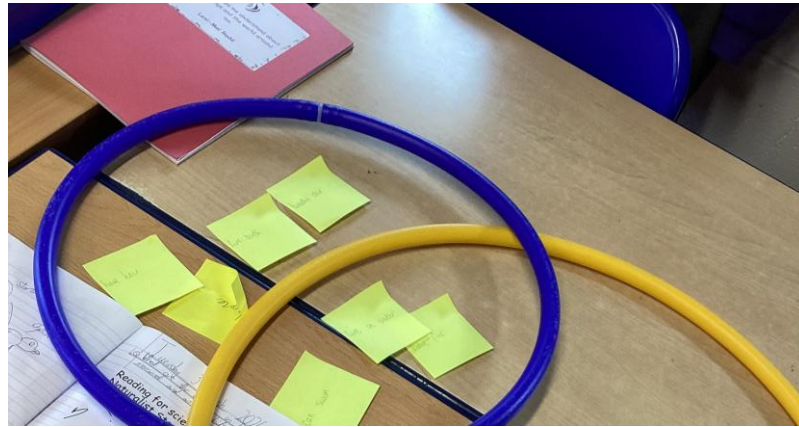
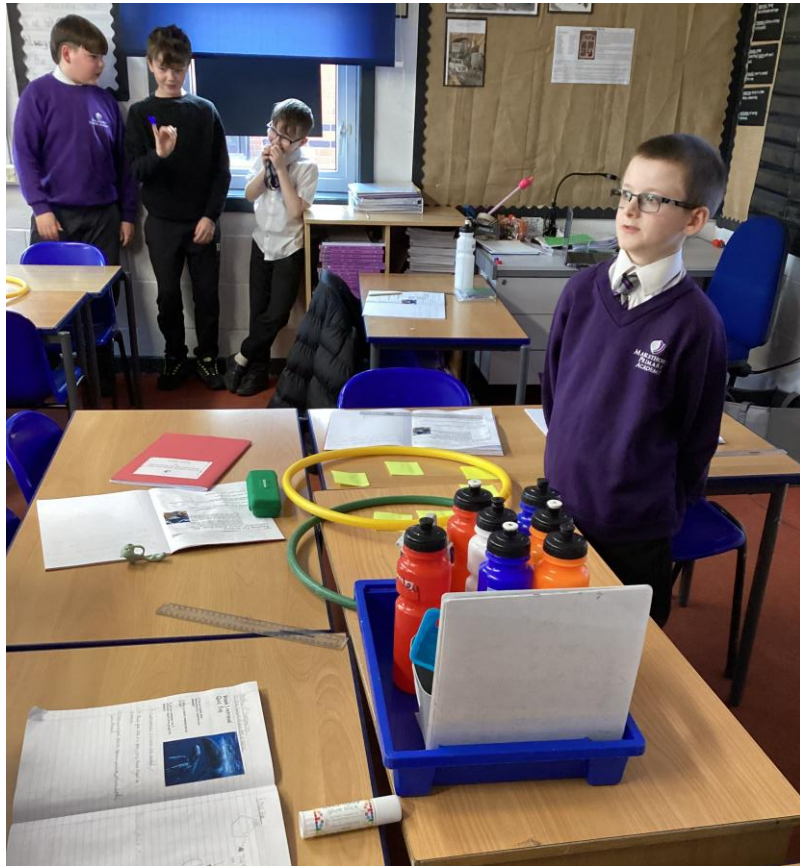

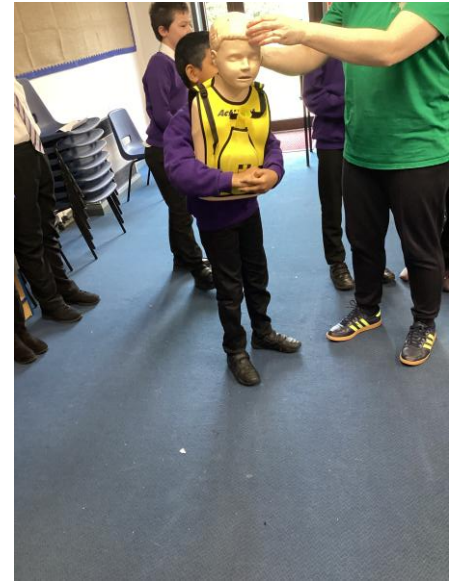
