**Habitat-** a place that an animal or a plant lives.

**Herbivore-** an animal that only eats plants.

**Minibeasts-** small creatures like worms, snails, insects and spiders.

**Microhabitats-** a very small, specific habitat for animals and plants.

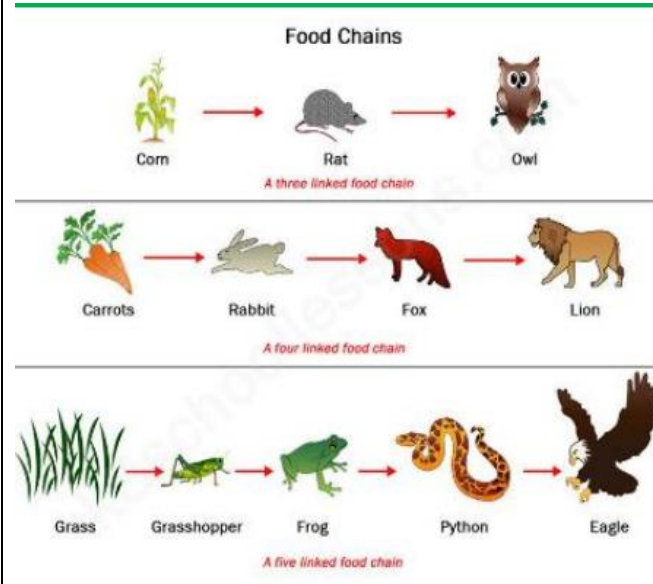
**Offspring-** a child or an animal in relation to its parents or parent.

**omnivore-** an animal that eats both meat and plants.

**Species-** a group of similar organisms that are able to reproduce.

**Survive-** to remain alive or in existence.

## Food chains



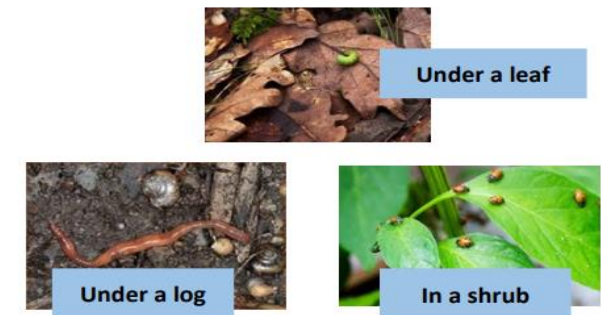
### What is a food chain?

A food chain is a sequence describing how different animals eat each other, showing the order in which living things depend on each other for food. Starting with a plant and ending with an animal, a food chain is a diagram showing how energy is transferred between different organisms in an ecosystem.
