Exploring pumpkins

- Explore a pumpkin at home with your child. Ask your child to draw a face on the pumpkin for you to carve for them.
Once you have used done the carving for your child, you can let them scoop out the flesh and the seeds from the inside of the pumpkin.
Ask your child, what does it smell like?
What does it feel like? Which parts of the pumpkin are hard and which are soft?

Making hotdogs

- As part of our Bonfire Night celebrations at school, we are making hot dogs. Remind your child of the importance of washing their hands before handling food.
Support your child in heating up their sausage, spreading butter on the butter and squirting on their own sauce.
Can your child press the buttons on the microwave with your help?
Can your child spread the butter with your help?

- Can your child make a pumpkin face using paints or cut out shapes of paper?
At school, we are looking at the shapes circle, triangle, square and rectangle.
Can your child name any of these shapes?
