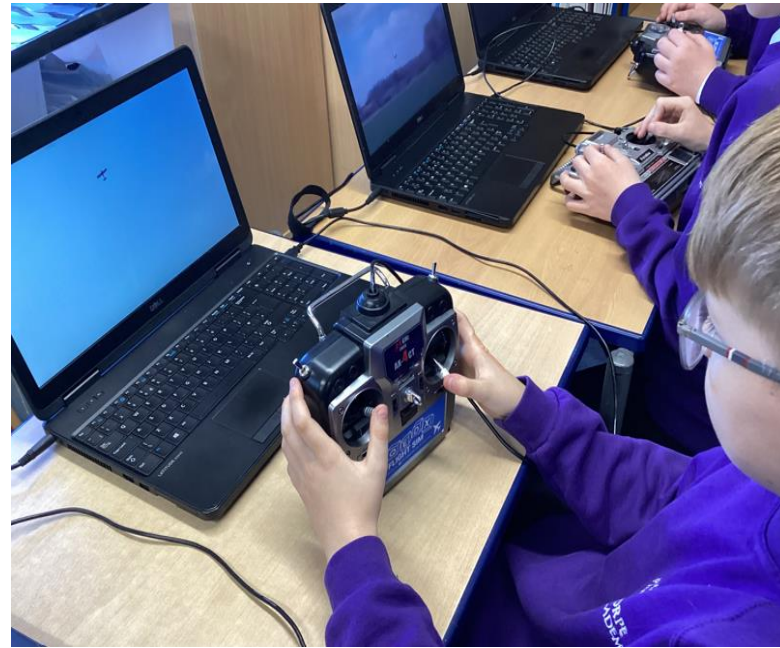




Macbeth Rehearsals

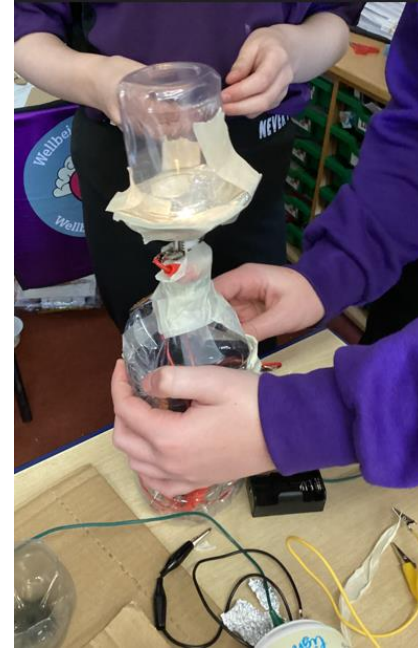
We have been reading through the scripts for Macbeth and exploring different ways to create atmospheres through use of live music.
