In DT this term, we have been exploring Anglo Saxon foods and making plans to create our own meals using ingredients that they would have had in those days.





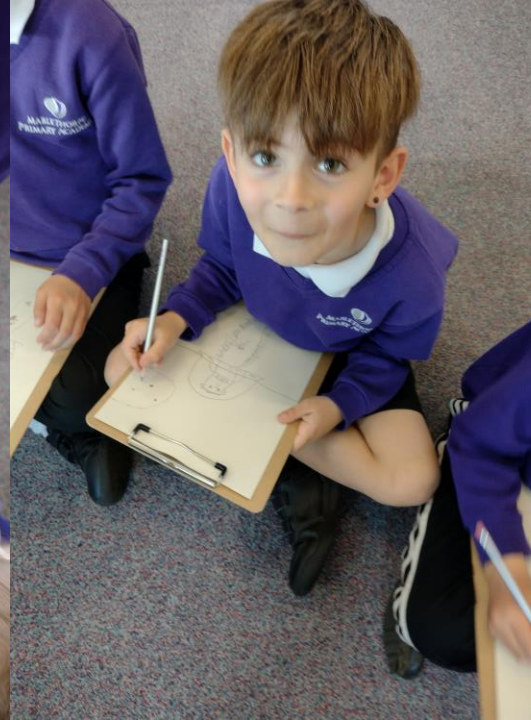
We headed to Willingham Woods for our geography fieldwork trip and enjoyed exploring the sights, sounds and smells of this beautiful woodland!

We enjoyed a visit to the library where we learned about how to be an author and join in with a draw along.



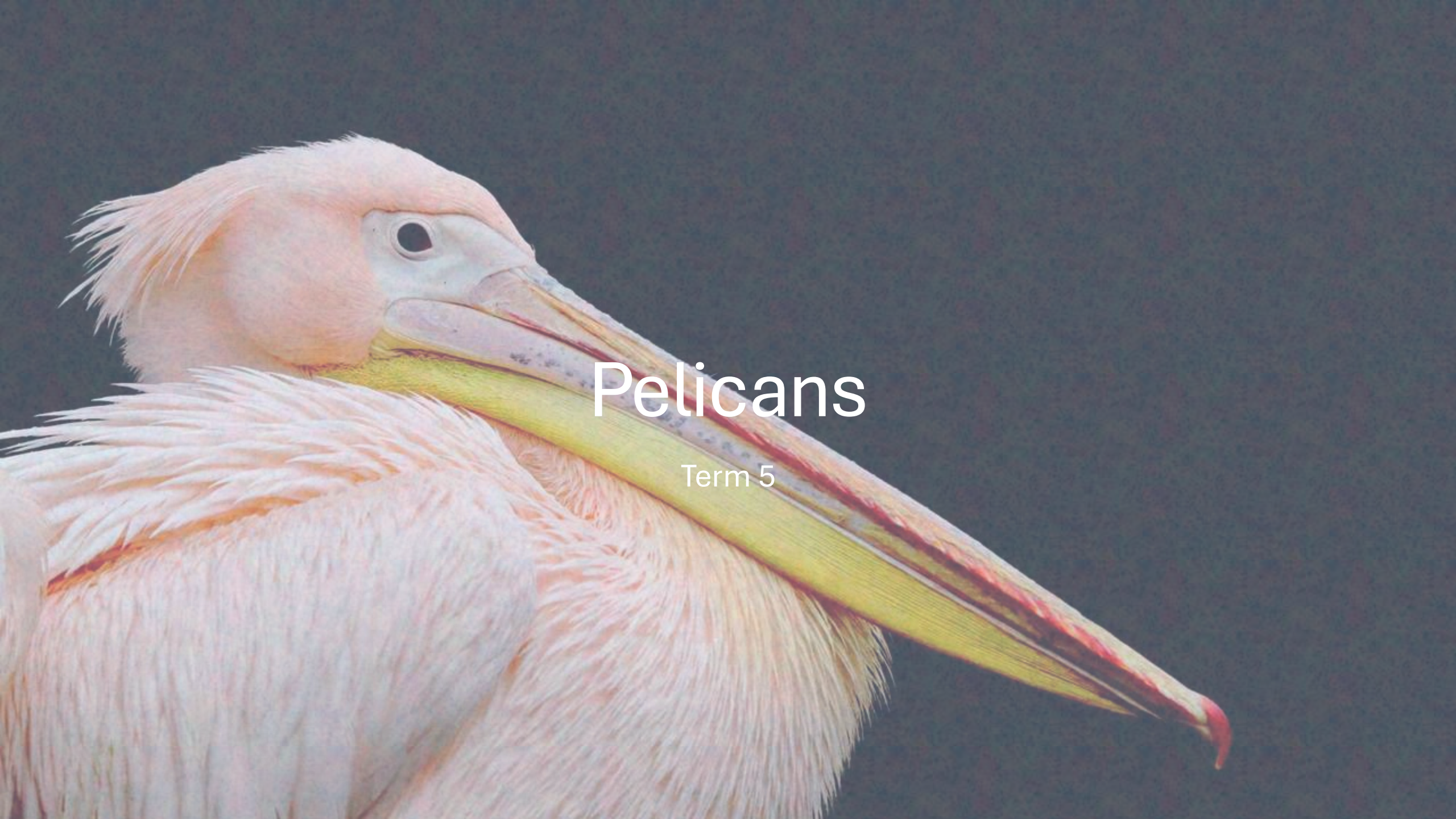


In DT we have designed and made our own stewed fruit meals inspired by the Anglo-Saxons.
