We have really enjoyed our unit on Athletics, we have been lucky with the weather and been able to use the field for most of our lessons!

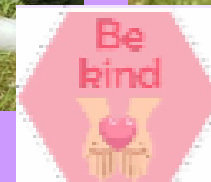
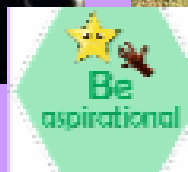
We've taken part in lots of fun races and activities as we work on developing our skills.

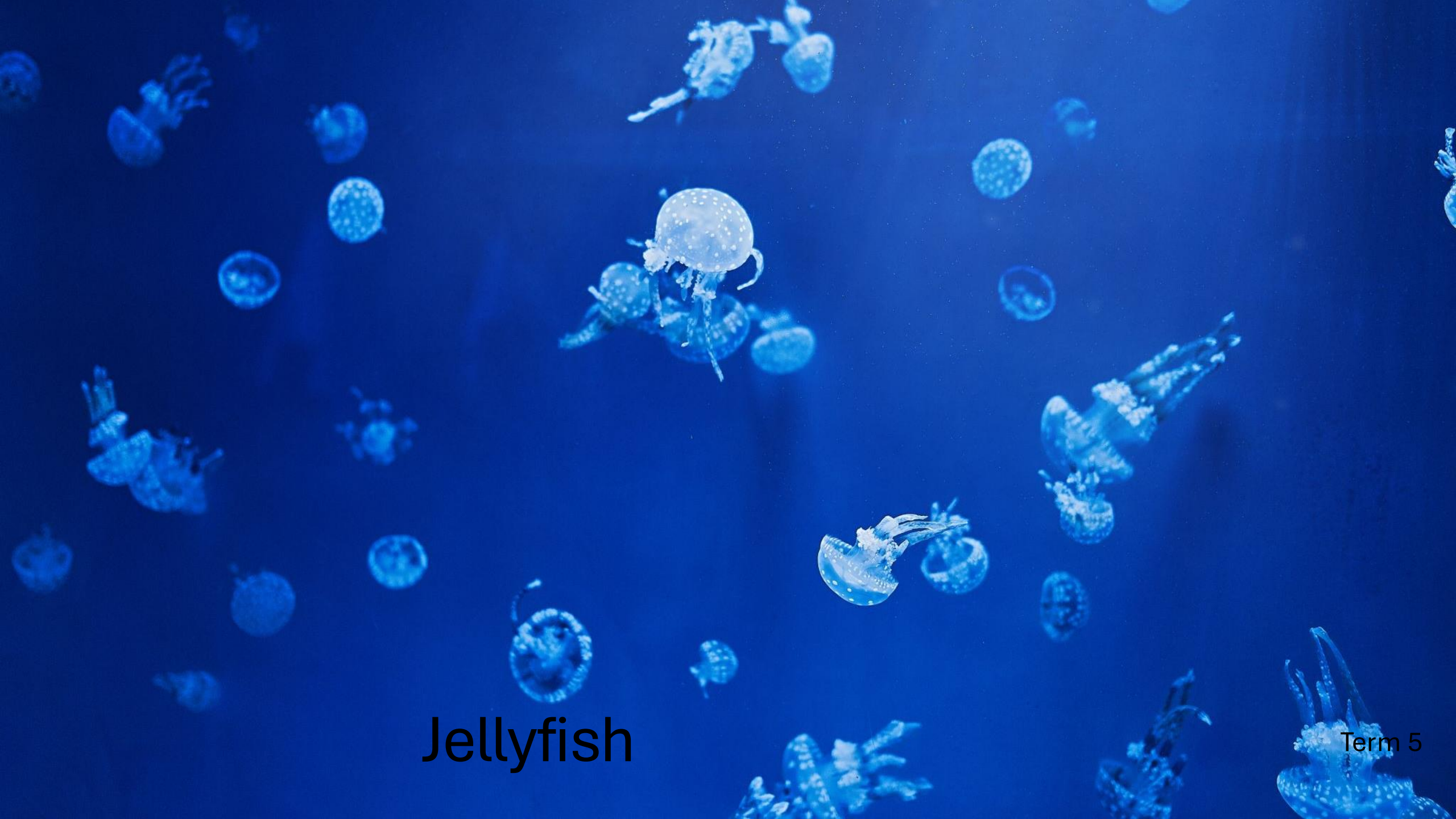


Woodlands!

Then we roasted marshmallows over the firepit to make smores! They tasted delicious!

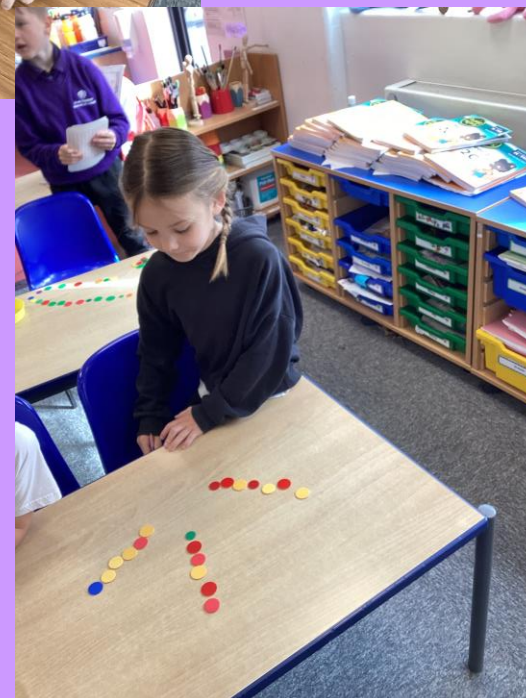


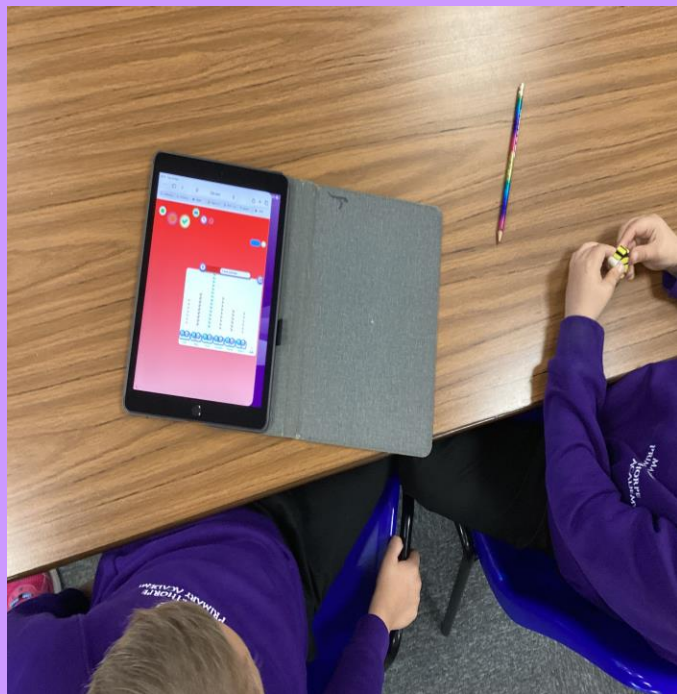
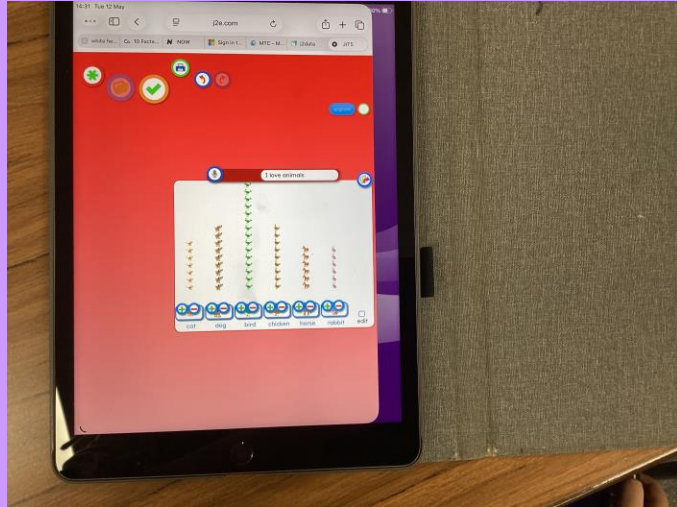


Jellyfish
