- The children created their own rocking pirate ship.



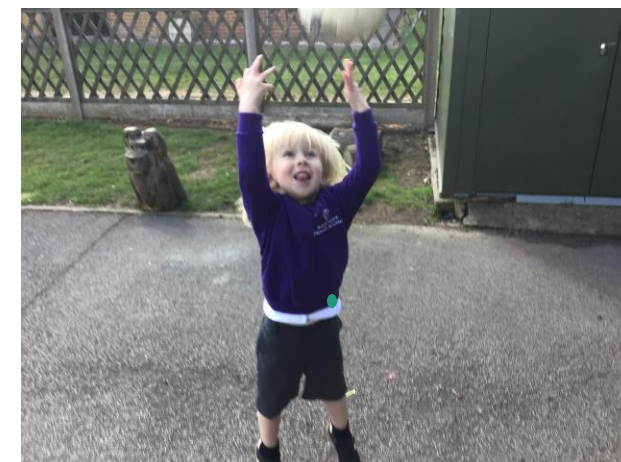
## Floating and Sinking

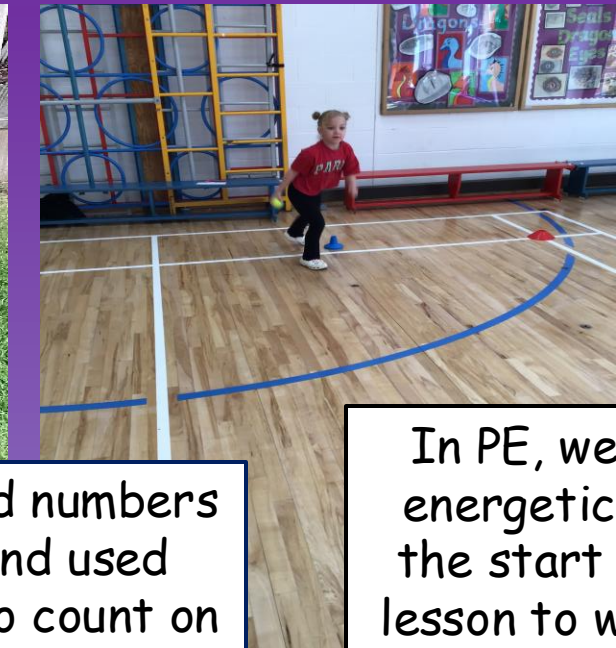
The children collected spring flowers and leaves to make a flower hanging. They rolled out the clay, used tools to make marks in it and then pressed in their flowers.

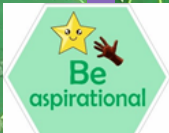

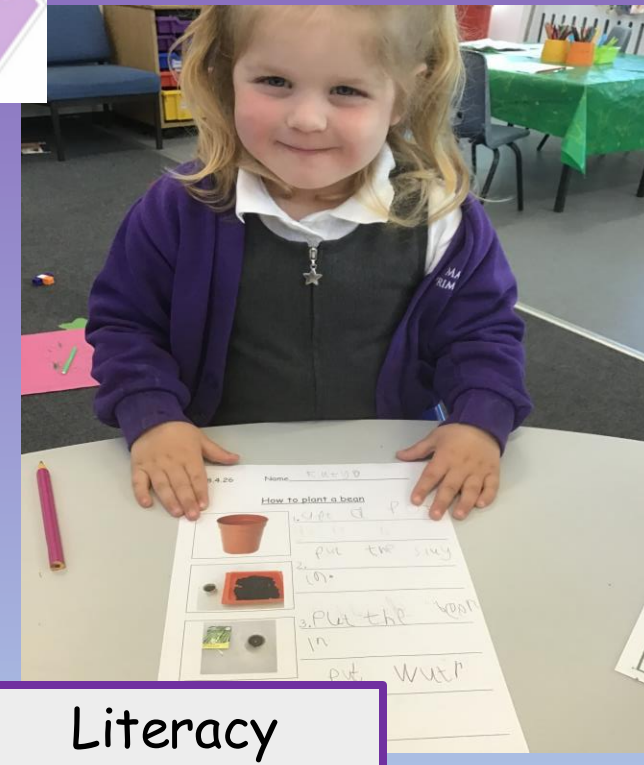
