Material- The substance used to make something is called a material.

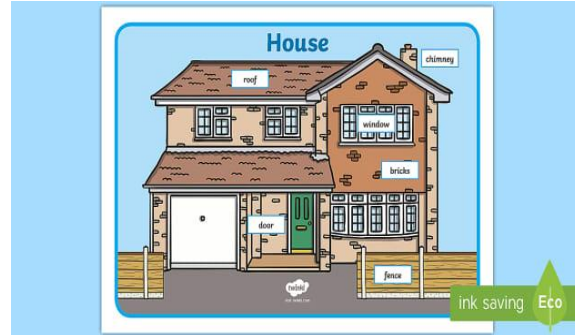
Properties- Materials have properties that help them serve specific purposes. For example, a chair is made of metal or wood because it is strong.

Waterproof- Something that keeps water out.

Not waterproof- soaks up water easily.

Seasons- The regular changes in the weather over the year.

The door is made from the material wood.



The windows are made from the material glass.



The walls are made from the material brick.



Properties of different materials	
Wood	strong, opaque, stiff, hard
Plastic	bendy, smooth, translucent, stretchy
Glass	transparent, hard, smooth, waterproof
Brick	rough, strong, opaque, dull
Paper	translucent, flexible, not waterproof
Cardboard	rough, dull, opaque, not waterproof
Metal	Shiny, strong, opaque, hard
Rock	Rough, strong, opaque, hard

Materials suitable for an Ipad



Plastic- bendy, smooth, bouncy, protective.
Rubber- bouncy, smooth, protective, waterproof.

Wood- hard, not bendy, not waterproof.



Plastic- soft, easily squashed, smooth.



Metal- shiny, smooth, hard, not bendy, waterproof



Rock- hard, bumpy, not bendy, waterproof.



Plasticine- bendy, twists, soft, waterproof, stretchy.



transparent (*see-through*)

translucent (*allows some light through but you can't see through it*)

opaque (*not see through*)
