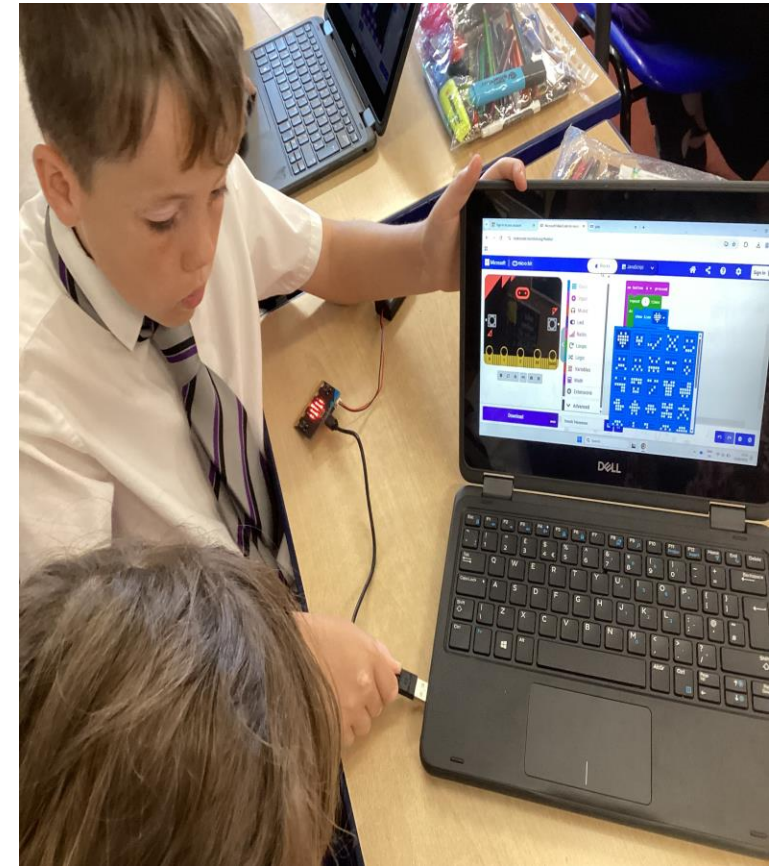
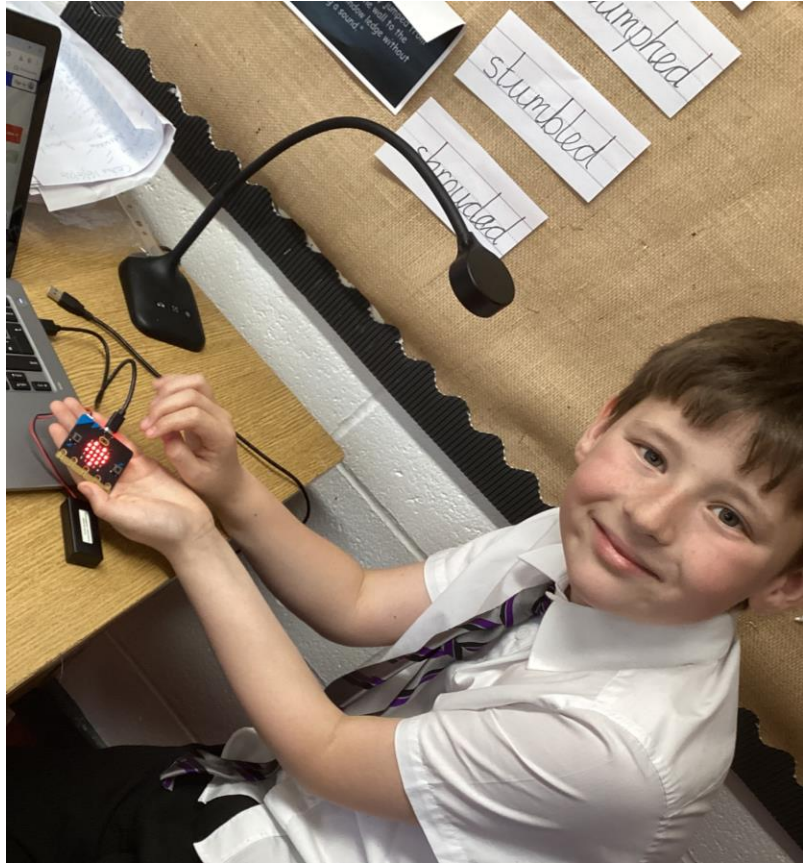

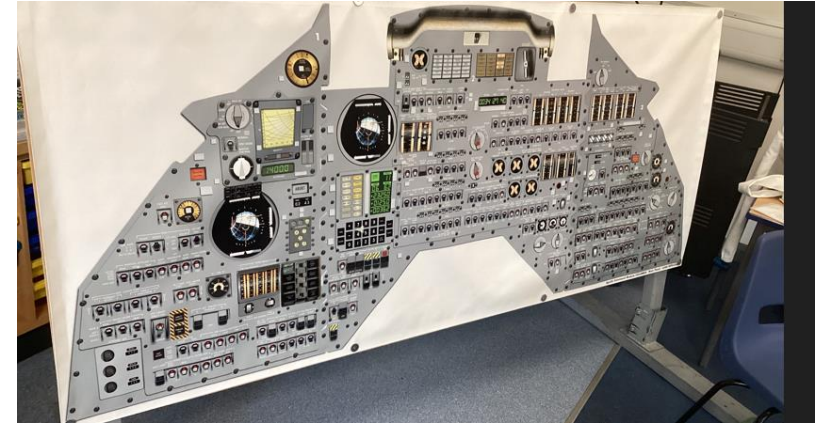
Welcome to Penguins Class Term 6 newsletter!

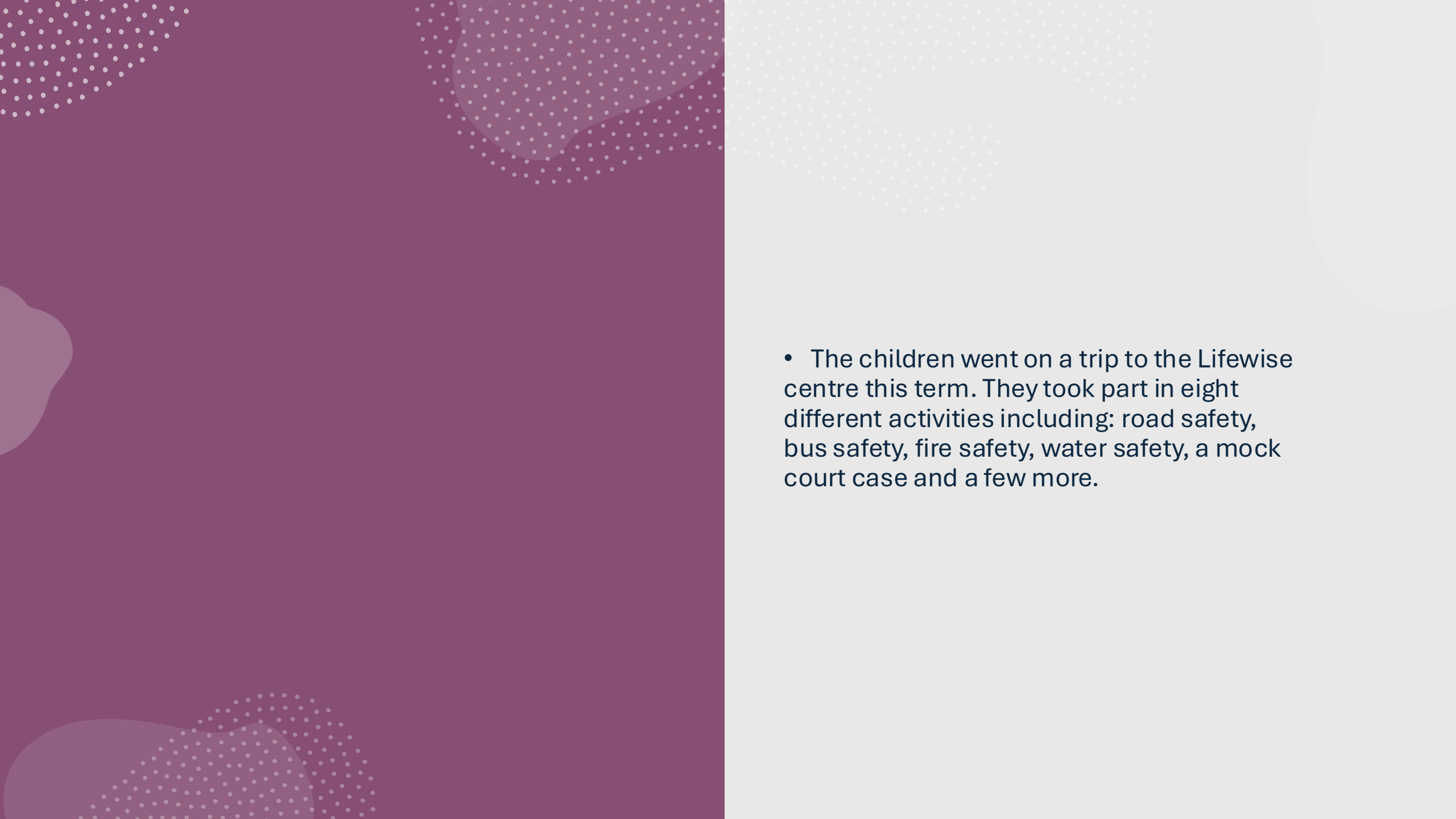






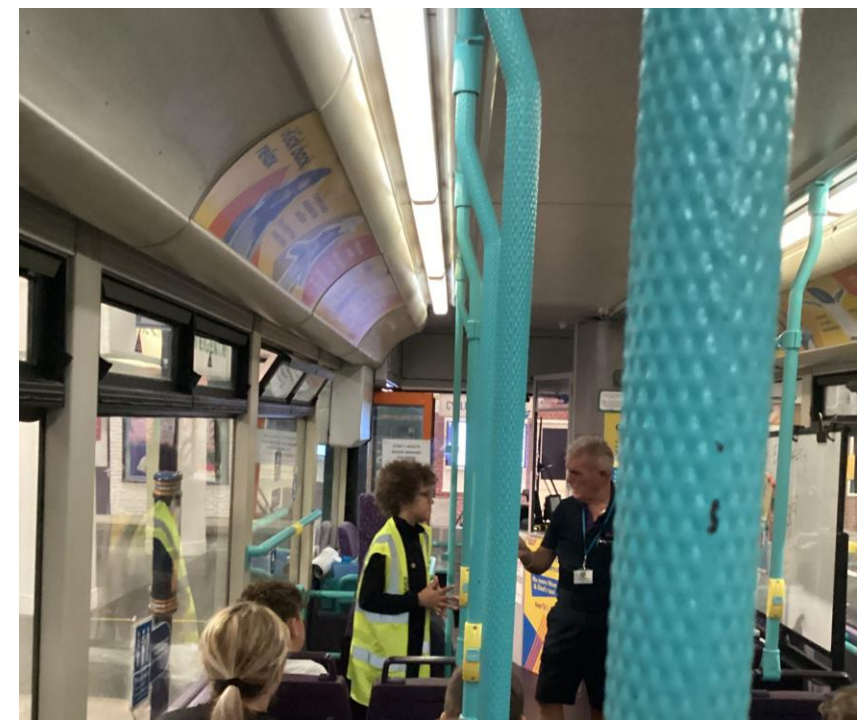
The children enjoyed taking part in online safety.
