We loved sharing our toys with our class, everyone had a different story to tell. We enjoyed our cucumber sandwiches and cakes in the shade.



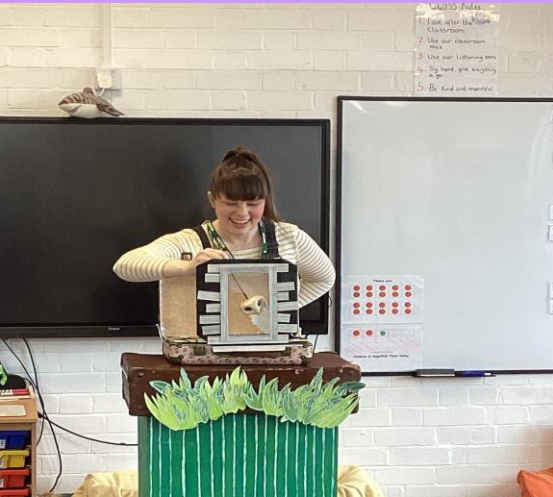
Space Race Day with Jed!

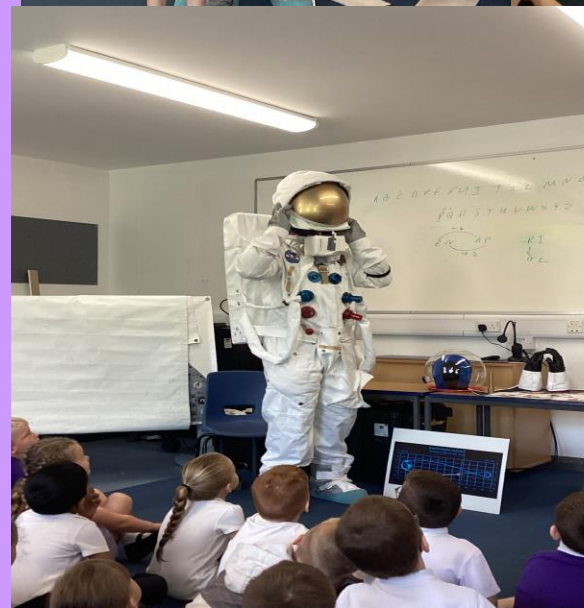

We made our own cucumber sandwiches and Fruit kebabs. We designed our kebabs as part of our DT work.



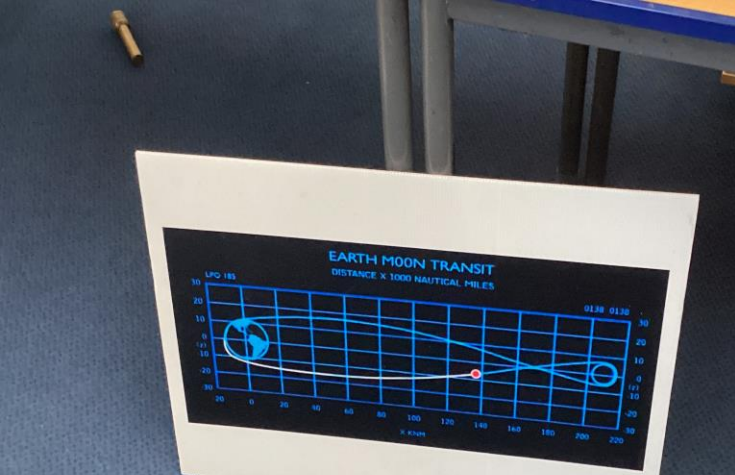
In PE with Mr Jones, we have been practicing our balling and batting skills.

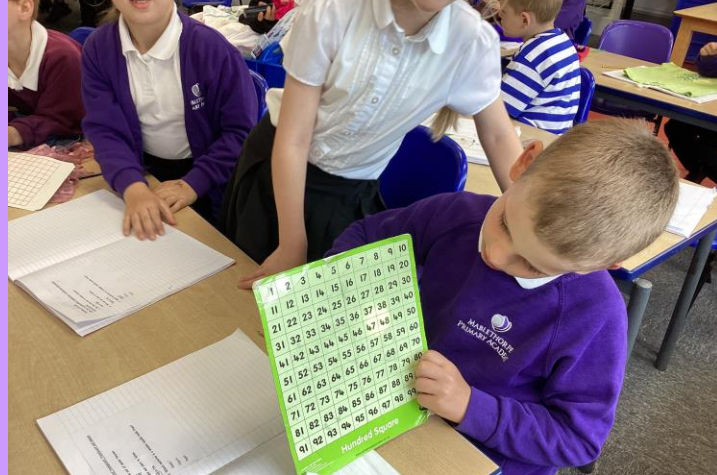
Jed arrived to teach us about the Space Race, the first mission to Mars and a monkey called Ham.
